Disclosure and Policy Statement

THIS DISCLOSURE STATEMENT DISCLAIMER is to assist the practitioner in complying with § 12-43-214, C.R.S., of the Mental Health Practice Act, § 12-43-101 et seq., C.R.S. As a licensed, registered, and/or certified mental health professional in the State of Colorado, **Animas Family Therapy** is in compliance with the provisions of the Mental Health Practice Act and any other state or federal statute governing the disclosure of information to clients. In order to comply with § 12-43-214(1)(b)(I), C.R.S:

- **A Registered Psychotherapist** is a psychotherapist listed in the State's database and is authorized by law to practice psychotherapy in Colorado, but is not licensed by the state and is not required to satisfy any standardized educational or testing requirements to obtain a registration from the state.

- **A Licensed Professional Counselor** must hold a master's or doctoral degree in professional counseling, have at least two years post-master's or one year postdoctoral practice, and pass an exam in in professional counseling.

Marianne Crom is a Tele-Health Credentialed Counselor, A National Credentialed Counselor, and registered and trained in EMDR.

She has a Bachelor's degree in Psychology and a Master's degree in Counseling.

You are aware that sexual intimacy is never appropriate and should be reported to the board that licensed the therapist. It is known that any information provided by the client during therapy sessions is legally confidential in the case of licensed marriage and family therapists, social workers, professional counselors, and psychologists; licensed or certified addiction counselors; and registered psychotherapists, except as provided in § 12- 43-218 and except for certain legal exceptions that will be identified as potential harm to oneself (suicide) or harm to someone else (homicide) or present abuse (physical or sexual) especially to a minor.

As a client, by signing this document you are aware of **Animas Family Therapy, LLC policy** that states you are responsible to call at least 24 hours prior to your appointment to cancel. If within the 24 hours, you are subject to the full fee for the session. Marianne Crom may be able to reschedule you without
